PRIDE 2023 - STRENGTH IN SOLIDARITY

The first World AIDS Day took place in 1988, providing a platform to raise awareness about HIV and AIDS and honor the lives affected by the epidemic. This year marks the 35th commemoration of this important day. Over the past 35 years, there has been significant progress in addressing HIV and AIDS thanks to advancements in medical research, increased access to treatment and prevention, and a broader understanding of the virus.

After four decades of living, organizing, and even dying in the HIV epidemic, individuals, communities, and institutions have been disrupted. The disease that would become known as HIV was first diagnosed among gay men in Los Angeles and New York in 1983. The epidemic in the United States began in a few communities—gay and bisexual men, trans people, injection drug users, hemophiliacs, and Haitian immigrants—all communities already stigmatized in society.

EDUCATION ASSISTANTANCE PROGRAM



Here at PRFI we believe in supporting our employees outside of the office as well. Through our education assistance program we are able to provide financial support to employees currently in school. This program allows for the reimbursement of up to \$2,000 per semester of cost of tuition, books and certain fees. To qualify for this program you must meet the following requirements:

- Full-time employees covered by the core benefit programs and who are actively atwork for over a year are eligible to use this program.
- Limited to 5 employees per semester.
- At least one year with the agency and in satisfactory job performance within their position. Complete all courses with an accredited college or university and achieve a satisfactory grade, no less than A and B.
- Classes and/or coursework must be relevant to their current position and/or career path.
- The application for refund with supporting documentation is made within 60 days after completion of the course-(reimbursement for eligible expenses will be processed and included in the next paycheck that is administratively possible and are considered taxable income unless otherwise exempted by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS)).
- Submit a recommendation letter from their supervisor.
- Employees on leaves of absence, and part-time, term contract, temporary and occasional employees are not eligible to participate. Employees who receive assistance from outside sources (scholarships, grants, GI Bill, fellowships, and other stipends) are not eligible for tuition reimbursement.
- PRFI reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to make a final and binding determination of whether an educational institution is approved and accredited for the purposes of the Educational Assistance Program.
- The application is included in the addendum section of this handbook and approval must be obtained from the Director of the Program.
- The application deadline for the Spring Semester will be December 21st and June 21st for the Fall Semester.
- If employees leave the organization within a year after receipt of
 reimbursement, they will be required to pay back the award.
